## MINUTES OF REGULAR MEETING OF THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE MACON MOSQUITO ABATEMENT DISTRICT OCTOBER 15, 2020

The regular meeting of the Board of Trustees of the Macon Mosquito Abatement District was called to order by Tom McQuistion on October 15, 2020, at the office of the Macon Mosquito Abatement District at 3755 Cundiff Road, Decatur, Illinois 62526. Trustees present were Carol Carlton, Tom McQuistion, and Susan Kretsinger. Also present were Director Jason Probus and Attorney Ross J. Munsterman. Absent were Dr. Robert Groesch and Sue Phillips. Tom McQuistion presided over the meeting.

The Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

During public comments, none.

The meeting was opened and a motion to approve the Minutes was made by Susan Kretsinger, seconded by Tom McQuistion, unanimously approved.

There was a motion made to approve the checks by Susan Kretsinger, seconded by Carol Carlton, and unanimously approved.

<u>DURING OLD BUSINESS</u>, none.

<u>DURING NEW BUSINESS</u>, Jason Probus discussed the bids the District received for replacing the HVAC system in the District office. The bids were for a 120,000 BTU 2-stage furnace and a 16 SEER air conditioning unit. The lowest bid was from Air King for \$6,909.00. Ameren has committed to reimburse \$2,100.00 of the cost following installation of the replacement unit. Jason recommended that the Board accept the bid from Air King. Tom McQuistion made a motion to accept the bid from Air King, Carol Carlton seconded, and the Board unanimously approved.

<u>DURING DIRECTOR'S COMMENTS</u>, Jason Probus informed the Board that the District's new "Field Seeker" software is close to being operational. The District was recently issued a permit from the Macon County Conservation District authorizing tick

and mosquito surveillance to be conducted in/near conservation areas. The District

plans to conduct surveillance by the bike path, Fairview Park, the dog park, and

perhaps at the old Scovill Golf Course. Tick season extends from late October through

November, but no more mosquito trapping will be conducted this year. All seasonal

employees have ceased employment at this time.

Overall for the year, there were 4 West Nile positive tests, but no human cases in

the District. Jason further discussed mosquito trapping/testing statistics for various

species of mosquitos in the State of Illinois. Tom asked Jason a question about our

trapping and testing procedures.

Jason informed the Board that the annual IMVCA meeting originally scheduled

for November will now be an online forum.

The District is preparing to sell a piece of surplus property (an old truck) that is no

longer needed. A new truck is on order and could be delivered in 3 weeks.

DURING TRUSTEE COMMENTS, Carol Carlton reminded Jason to turn in

paperwork to the Macon County Health Department so that the District could receive

grant funds. Jason informed Carol that he believed that the paperwork was already

completed but he would check again.

DURING EXECUTIVE SESSION, none.

Subsequently, a motion was made by Carol Carlton, seconded by Susan

Kretsinger, and unanimously approved for adjournment.
