

**MINUTES OF REGULAR MEETING OF THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF
THE MACON MOSQUITO ABATEMENT DISTRICT
August 21, 2025**

The regular meeting of the Board of Trustees of the Macon Mosquito Abatement District was called to order by Tom McQuiston on August 21, 2025, at the office of the Macon Mosquito Abatement District at 4170 N. Bearsdale Rd., Decatur, Illinois 62526. Trustees present were Greg Foley, Jerry Allen Brown Jr, Tom McQuiston and Travis Wilcoxen. Also present were Jason Probus and Attorney Patrick C. Sullivan. Absent was Lillian Baldwin.

Tom McQuiston presided over the meeting.

The Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

During public comments, none.

The meeting was opened and a motion to approve the Minutes was made by Greg Foley, seconded by Tom McQuiston, and unanimously approved.

There was a motion made to approve the checks by Travis Wilcoxen, seconded by Jerry Allen Brown Jr., and unanimously approved.

DURING OLD BUSINESS, Motion to approve the budget presented as Ordinance 25-1 by Travis Wilcoxen, seconded by Jerry Allen Brown Jr., and unanimously approved.

DURING NEW BUSINESS, None.

DURING DIRECTOR'S COMMENTS, (A) Jason reported 53 positive West Nile cases in Illinois, 9 human cases, none in Macon County, the 22nd Street corridor is a growing concern, and Jason hopes to speak to ADM about accessing its property to remediate/test; (B) Jason has advised certain local villages they are required to give public notice prior to spraying, MMAD has not sprayed yet; (C) the seasonal workers' last day was today, traps will now be monitored by Jason, Randy and Alexis; (D) roof leaks in garage continue, during last week's storm, 5 of the 8 skylights leaked, and the foundation leaked, the warranty on construction is set to expire after this month; (E) Jason settled the disputed bill with Alltech, agreeing to split it 50/50.

DURING TRUSTEE COMMENTS, MMAD receives a grant from the Macon County Health Department to complete tick drags, and MMAD completed more than the 4 required drags during spring, there will be 2 more during the fall; the MCHD has not yet determined how much the 2025-2026 grant for the tick drags will be.

DURING EXECUTIVE SESSION, none.

Subsequently, a motion was made by Tom McQuiston, seconded by Greg Foley and unanimously approved for adjournment.
